- Why does the House have a capital letter in Esther's mind?
- Most of Esther's knowledge of the world comes from old films and books. How does this add to her confusion when she steps into the real world? And what are the things that confuse her?
- How does the addition of Hannah's story add to our understanding of the character?
- When does Mr Wiffles stop talking to Esther? Why does it happen at this point and what is the significance of this?
- Why do you think Hannah kills herself at the end?
- Did you find the ending satisfying or not? Why?
